Fruit/Seeds: leaves	Greenish $1/8$ " flower open in May (male and female at base of young in Spring) with $1/3$ " orange-red fruit that ripens to dark purple (in Fall)		
Leaves: has a long poi	Shiny green ovate leaves smooth or rough on top/paler on bottom, int with three main veins. Underside of leaf feels hairy under main vein		
Habitat:	Generally in river valle	ys, upland slopes and bluffs
