Botanical Name:	<i>x Cupressus x leylandii</i> (koo press us lay LAN dee eye)
Common Name(s):	Leyland Cypress
Height:	35-130 feet by 15-25 feet
Form, Branches, Twigs:	crown is columnar; oval; pyramidal and dense upright evergreen
Fruits/Seeds:	Round less than .5 inch brown fruit
Leaves:	blue, blue-green or green, scale like flat hanging sprays up to 12"
Habitat:	Can grow in full sun, part sun or part shade, will grow in most soils but prefers well drained soils. High drought tolerance and is moderately salt tolerant, prone to many pest and diseases

**(*Seiridium cardinale* causes a canker disease which will eventually kill the Leyland Cypress)
