

Botanical Name:	Acer saccharum Marsh. (A ser sak KAR um)
Common Name(s):	Sugar, Hard or Rock Maple
Height:	70-100' by 2-3'
Form, Branches, Twigs:	Dense crown has an upright oval to rounded habit (young trees pyramidal with smooth gray brown bark) Older bark has long deeply furrowed narrow scaly ridgehowever bark is extremely variable. Twigs are slender and greenish brown to gray.
Fruits/Seeds:	Hairless samara (1.75")September/October. Wings are almost parallel
Leaves:	Simple3-6" opposite leaves with 3-5 lobes with a slightly coarse toothed toothed margin with narrow deep sinuses
Habitat:	TN is southern edge of its habitat. Prefers moist uplands and valley soils
